Money Required by the Participants: \$20 per couple (or other specified spending limit)

How it Works:

1. To give direction to your couples as they shop, consider establishing a theme for the night (decade era, sports theme, color theme, rainbow theme, animal)
2. As couples arrive, consider an icebreaker (included in the Date Night kit)
3. Each couple receives a [judging card](#) and selects **one** person to “dress up” for the fashion show. The other person is their stylist and support :)
4. Set a time limit (one hour should be sufficient, depending on your location to the nearest stores), make sure everyone understands what counts towards extra points.
5. Every couple must submit their receipts to prove that their purchases do not exceed spending limit
6. As everyone returns back into the meeting spot, they should be dressed and ready!
7. Have exciting music playing and each participant comes up to show what they found
8. The judging panel (3 people are ideal to break a tie) will decide the winner. The winner will earn a prize (Need a gift card to a local restaurant? Contact MREC! We are happy to provide this to your winning couple).

To wrap up the evening, consider these talking points:

1. Challenge them to focus on a specific theme (decade/sport), and do this again by themselves, with another couple, or with their kids.
2. Opportunities like this get us out of the daily routine, which can help us from becoming stagnant in the mundane tasks of the day. Good job everyone for investing in each other!
3. Provide a “what’s next”- be mindful of couples that really enjoyed the evening. Maybe they can help plan the next one!
