

Steps to Establishing or Enhancing Marriage Ministry in the Local Church



Seek wisdom and unity with senior pastors, elders, and key ministry leaders.

Cover the vision in prayer, asking the Lord for guidance, support, and discernment.



Incorporate marriage-related content into sermons, prayers, and announcements.

Publicly share the intention to support marriages through a new or revitalized ministry.

Understand the current health of marriages in the congregation.

Identify needs, concerns, and topics for future ministry focus.



Recruit passionate, spiritually mature couples with a variety lists of gifts and talents to help lead.

Clearly communicate roles and expectations as interest grows.



Define goals, purpose or mission (e.g., strengthening communication, enriching marriages).

Outline key events and measurable outcomes.

Include Marriage Ministry in the Church Budget

Plan for training, resources, events, childcare, and promotional materials.



Equip leaders with biblical foundations and review confidentiality guidelines.

Possibly partner with external marriage ministries or use proven curriculum.*



Start small group gatherings for couples (varied by life stage or topic).

Focus on connection, learning, and support.



Identify emerging leaders from small groups.

Provide additional training and mentoring to expand the ministry's reach.



Regularly assess progress with feedback from couples and leaders.

Celebrate wins and adjust based on what's working or needs improvement.
